More women wanted

THEY might have won Olympic gold, scaled the world's tallest mountains, or are leaders in otherwise male-dominated fields.

The search is on for outstanding women to include on the Victorian Honour Roll of Women.

An impressive line-up of women already inscribed on the roll called yesterday for nominations for the 2007 intake.

Flanked by mountaineer Bridgette Muir, Olympic gold medallist, Cathy Freeman, and cancer researcher, Vasso Apostolopoulos, Victorian police commissioner Christine Nixon yesterday appealed for suggestions for next year's induction.

"We reflect the qualities and strengths of many women across this country, and many of them never get any recognition at all," Ms Nixon said.

The foursome already on the list is among 356 women, all of whom are considered to have made an important contribution to life in Victoria.

About 20 names are added annually.

Prof Apostolopoulos spoke with her six-month-old daughter propped on her hip.

"She's my first," she said of little Vivian Tzavaras.

"It's very hard juggling work and being a mother, but you just have to be more organised. It is difficult but you can achieve both."
